Cross the world's highest motorable road, Umling La, standing at 19,024 feet, and feel the thrill of riding through history, cinema, and the adventure of a lifetime.

You'll conquer legendary passes like Khardung La and Umling La and experience Zoji La, Tanglang La, and Baralacha La, all while riding through some of the most beautiful and remote areas of Ladakh. From the bustling streets of Leh to the peaceful beauty of Hanle, Tso Moriri, and Pangong, every mile you travel will offer unforgettable views, pristine lakes, and the kind of adventure that only the roads you travel can offer.

This trip is about more than just the roads—it's about facing challenges, conquering your fears, and pushing yourself to the limit. By the end of it, you'll not only feel like a conqueror of mountains but also part of a community of like-minded riders who share a passion for exploration.

ITINERARY

Day :0 Departure From Delhi – The Journey To The Mountains Begins

- Your journey begins as you head to the pickup point and board your overnight transfer to Manali.
- This is where the trip energy starts building, you'll meet your fellow riders and your trip captain, who will be leading the group and making sure every day feels like an adventure worth remembering.
- As the city lights fade behind you, the road turns into a vibe with music, conversations, and the excitement of what's coming next.
- Along the way, you'll stop at local highway dhabas for hot tea and late-night snacks, the perfect fuel for the ride ahead.
- Settle in, rest well, and recharge, because tomorrow you wake up in the mountains and the real journey begins.

Day 1: Arrival in Manali: Self-Exploration of Manali

- As the sun rises over the Himalayas, you'll finally arrive in Manali, often called the Valley of Gods.
- You'll head straight to your mountain hotel, where a warm welcome and hot tea await you.
- After checking in and resting for a bit, you'll begin exploring some of Manali's most iconic spots.
- Start with the serene Hidimba Temple, surrounded by tall deodar trees, and then take a short hike to Jogni Waterfall, a hidden green escape that feels refreshing and peaceful.
- Later, relax at the natural hot water springs at Vashisht Temple, the perfect way to soothe your body before days of riding.
- In the evening, explore Manali's lively streets for shopping, cafés, and local food, from steaming momos to siddu.
- The day ends with a detailed trip briefing by the captain, where you'll learn about road conditions, permits, bike checks, and safety measures, ensuring you feel confident and prepared for the adventure that begins tomorrow.
- Overnight stay in Manali.

Day 2: Ride From Manali To Sarchu: Via Atal Tunnel, The Adventure Begins

- After breakfast, you'll do a final check of your riding gear and meet the group for a quick ride briefing before starting your first major ride of the expedition.
- The adventure officially begins as you ride through the legendary Atal Tunnel, one of the world's longest tunnels at this altitude, and emerge into the rugged landscapes of Lahaul Valley.
- The scenery turns dramatic as the Chandra River flows beside you and the mountains begin to look wilder with every kilometre.
- You'll cross charming towns like Keylong and ride through remote stretches like Darcha and Patsio, making stops at high-altitude points like Zingzing Bar for tea and to catch your breath.
- Later, you'll witness the stunning Suraj Tal Lake, a crystal-clear alpine lake that feels like a postcard, before climbing up to Baralacha La Pass at 4,829 metres, where the real highaltitude riding begins to hit.
- By evening, you'll arrive in Sarchu, a vast cold desert that feels like another planet
- Check into your comfortable camps, enjoy a warm meal, share stories around the campfire, and fall asleep under an unbelievably star-filled sky.
- Overnight stay in Sarchu.

Day 3: Sarchu To Leh

- Wake up to crisp mountain air, pack up, gear up, and get ready for one of the most thrilling rides of the trip.
- Today is a full biker's dream day, packed with iconic routes and high-altitude milestones.
- You begin with the legendary Gata Loops, a series of 21 sharp hairpin bends that test your skill and endurance while giving you unreal mountain views.
- The ride continues as you conquer Nakee La and Lachung La, both towering high passes that make you feel like you're riding through the sky.
- Stop at Pang, a high-altitude military transit camp, for a much-needed hot meal before heading into one of the most surreal landscapes of the entire route – the Moore Plains.
- This 50-kilometre stretch of open straight road at extreme altitude feels endless, cinematic, and freeing, and if you're lucky, you might spot marmots or wild kiang running across the plains.
- Next comes Tanglang La, another major milestone where the winds are colder, but the views are even bigger.
- By evening, you'll arrive in Leh, check into your hotel, and finally experience the feeling of reaching Ladakh after days of riding.
- Overnight stay in Leh.

Day 4: Leh To Nubra Valley Via Khardung La, Riding Through The Clouds

- Before leaving Leh, you will make a quick stop at Shanti Stupa for panoramic views and a peaceful start to the day.
- Then, it's time for a heart-racing climb to Khardung La, one of the world's highest motorable passes.
- The ride up is thrilling and iconic, and reaching the top feels like a serious achievement.
- As you descend from the pass, the landscape transforms dramatically – rugged mountains open into wide valleys, the Shyok River winds through the terrain, and Nubra Valley begins to feel like a different world.
- You'll visit Diskit Monastery, home to the massive 106-foot Maitreya Buddha statue overlooking the valley, and then head to Hunder, famous for its rolling sand dunes and rare double-humped Bactrian camels.
- You can also opt for an ATV ride in the dunes for a full adventure experience.
- As night falls, Nubra becomes even more magical, offering one of the best stargazing skies in Ladakh.
- Overnight stay in Nubra Valley.

Day 5: Nubra To Pangong Via Shyok Valley The Blue Lake Day

- Wake up in Nubra Valley to crisp mountain air and get ready for one of the most scenic rides of the trip as we head toward the iconic Pangong Tso.
- The route today is adventurous and stunning, taking us through the charming villages of Agam and Shyok, surrounded by rugged mountains and dramatic landscapes that feel straight out of a movie.
- As we ride deeper into this remote terrain, the excitement builds until the majestic Pangong Lake finally appears, shining in endless shades of blue at an altitude of 4,300 metres.
- We'll spend time by the lake, soaking in the calm, clicking those must-have shots with mountain reflections on the water, and visiting the famous 3 Idiots photo spot.
- Later, we'll check into our lakeside campsite, enjoy a warm dinner with the group, and end the night under a sky full of stars with the soothing sounds of Pangong in the background.
- Overnight stay near Pangong Lake.

Day 6: Pangong To Hanle Via Rezing La Remote Roads And Hero Stories

- Start your morning with unforgettable views of Pangong Lake and enjoy breakfast at the campsite before we begin another thrilling ride, this time toward Hanle, one of Ladakh's most remote and untouched regions.
- On the way, we'll pass through Chushul, a high-altitude border town known for its strategic importance and dramatic landscapes.
- Our most powerful stop today will be the Rezing La War Memorial, built in honour of the brave Indian soldiers who gave their lives during the 1962 Indo-China war.
- After paying respects, we'll continue our ride through vast open roads and rugged terrain, stopping for lunch along the way depending on time.
- We'll cross the iconic Loma Bridge over the Indus River and ride through landscapes that feel completely wild and untouched, arriving in Hanle by evening.
- After check-in, we'll enjoy a warm dinner and settle into the peaceful vibe of this quiet mountain village.
- Overnight stay in Hanle.

Day 7: Umling La Excursion Conquer The Highest Motorable Road In The World

- Today is the ultimate expedition day.
- After breakfast, we gear up for the most thrilling ride of the trip – a journey to Umling La, the highest motorable road in the world.
- The roads today are rough, remote, and absolutely unforgettable as we climb higher through Ladakh's extreme terrain, crossing Photi La at 5,524 metres along the way.
- Every kilometre feels like a victory as we push toward Umling La at 5,640 metres, higher than Everest Base Camp.
- Standing at the top is a moment of pure achievement – panoramic views, epic photos, and the kind of feeling you'll remember forever.
- On the way back, we'll cross another high-altitude pass, Nurbu La, before stopping for lunch and heading back toward Hanle.
- If time permits, we may visit the famous Hanle Observatory, the highest space observatory in India known for its advanced astronomical research.
- By evening, we return to our homestay, enjoy dinner with the group, and rest after a day that truly feels like a once-in-a-lifetime milestone.
- Overnight stay in Hanle.

Day 8: Hanle To Leh Via Chumathang Scenic Return To Base

- Wake up early in Hanle and watch the sunrise paint the Ladakh ranges in shades of orange and pink – one of those quiet moments that makes the whole journey feel worth it.
- After breakfast, we begin our scenic drive back to Leh, passing through beautiful towns like Chumathang, Upshi, Karu, Thiksey, and Shey.
- The roads today are calm and picturesque, giving us time to reflect on the adventure we've just experienced.
- By evening, we'll arrive in Leh and check in to the hotel.
- The night is yours to explore Leh Market, go café hopping, shop for souvenirs, or simply relax with your travel fam and soak in the last few moments in the city.
- Overnight stay in Leh.

Day 9: Leh To Kargil Via Namika La And Fotu La

- After breakfast, we leave Leh behind and begin our ride toward Kargil, with some legendary stops along the way.
- Our first stop is the Hall of Fame, a tribute to the Indian Army that gives you a deep sense of pride and a stronger connection to the land you've been riding through.
- Next, we visit Gurudwara Pathar Sahib, a peaceful and sacred place dedicated to Guru Nanak Dev Ji.
- From here, we head to Magnetic Hill, where the landscape creates an optical illusion that makes vehicles appear to roll uphill – a fun and mind-bending stop
- We'll also visit the Sangam Point, where the Indus and Zaskar rivers meet, creating a stunning view that feels cinematic
- Later, we ride through the famous moon-like landscapes of Lamayuru before climbing two major passes, Namika La and Fotu La, with breathtaking views all around.
- We reach Kargil by evening, check in, freshen up, enjoy dinner, and rest after an adventure-packed day. Overnight stay in Kargil.

Day 10: Kargil To Srinagar Via Sonmarg, Drass & Zoji La

- Today you begin your return journey to Srinagar, known as paradise on Earth, and the ride is full of dramatic scenery and iconic roads.
- You'll pass through Drass, the second coldest inhabited place in the world, often called the Gateway to Ladakh.
- The highlight of the day is crossing Zoji La Pass, one of India's most thrilling and adventurous high-altitude routes with sharp turns and raw terrain that makes every rider feel accomplished.
- Later, you'll stop at Sonmarg, a beautiful golden meadow that once lay on the ancient Silk Route, offering stunning valley views and a perfect pause to breathe it all in.
- By evening, you'll arrive in Srinagar, check into your hotel, unwind, and enjoy the Kashmiri vibes one last time as the trip wraps up with memories that will stay with you forever.
- Overnight stay in Srinagar.

Day 11: Kargil To Srinagar

- Wake up to a peaceful morning in Srinagar, enjoy breakfast, and pack your bags as the journey comes to an end.
- You will be transferred to Srinagar Airport for your onward flight home.
- While the trip concludes here, the memories will stay with you forever – the high passes, the remote roads, the friendships made on the ride, and the feeling of accomplishing something truly epic

INCLUSIONS WITH ROADS YOU TRAVEL

- Volvo transfer from Delhi to Manali (Not included for self bike option).
- Bike Rent for 7 days Sarchu to Srinagar from Day 3 to Day 9. (For Biking Option)
- Fuel for the bike(Sarchu to Srinagar).
- Entire travel from Manali to Srinagar by tempo traveler/cab (For Tempo Traveler Option)
- Stay for 9 nights – 1 night in a hotel at Srinagar, 1 night in a hotel at Kargil, 2 nights in a hotel at Leh, 2 nights in a hotel/camps at Diskit, 1 night in camps at Pangong Tso, 1 night in camps at Sarchu & 1 night in a hotel at Manali on triple sharing basis
- A total of 17 meals – 1 meal Day 1(B) + 1 meal Day 2 (D) + 2 meals Day 3 (B+D) + 2 meals Day 4 (B+D) + 2 meals Day 5 (B+D) + 2 meals Day 6 (B+D) + 2 meals Day 7 (B+D) + 2 meals Day 8 (B+D) + 2 meals Day 9 (B+D) + 1 meal Day 10 (B)
- Riding Gears – Helmet (Standard Size 58 - 60 cms), Riding Gloves (only for riders), Riding Jackets, Knee Pads (Though it is recommended you carry your own helmet for comfort)
- Team Captain throughout the trip.
- Mechanical Backup. Daily bike check up.
- Spare wheels will be carried in case of puncture so that you don't have to wait.
- All inner line permits for the trip.
- Driver Night Charges, Toll Tax, Parking Charges, etc.
- Medical Kit & An Oxygen Cylinder 24X7 in the car in case of emergency.

WHAT'S NOT IN THE VICATION PACKAGE

- GST (5%) is applicable extra.
- Any kind of food or beverage that is not included in the package like alcoholic drinks, mineral water, meals/refreshments/lunches on the highway.
- Any personal expenses like a tip to the drivers, entry to monuments/monasteries, camera/video camera charges, camel safari, river rafting, laundry, telephone bills, tips, etc
- Any cost arising due to natural calamities like landslides, roadblocks etc. (to be borne directly by the customer on the spot)
