From the bustling streets of Leh to the peaceful beauty of Hanle, Tso Moriri, and Pangong, every mile you travel will offer unforgettable views, pristine lakes, and the kind of adventure that only the roads you travel can offer.

This trip is about more than just the roads—it's about facing challenges, conquering your fears, and pushing yourself to the limit. By the end of it, you'll not only feel like a conqueror of mountains but also part of a community of like-minded riders who share a passion for exploration.

ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrival in Srinagar – A day of leisure & exploration

- Your journey begins the moment you land in Srinagar, the summer capital of Jammu and Kashmir.
- After arrival, you will transfer to your iconic houseboat and check in, instantly feeling the calm and charm of Dal Lake.
- Take some time to unwind and soak in the peaceful surroundings before heading out for a Shikara ride.
- Later, you can explore Srinagar's vibrant local markets, shop for pashmina shawls, and sip on warm Kashmiri kahwa at a cozy corner café.
- In the evening, you will meet your team captain for a detailed trip briefing, including road insights, bike checks, and safety pointers, setting the tone for the epic ride ahead.
- End the night with dinner and fall asleep to the gentle ripples of the lake, excited for the adventure that begins tomorrow.
- Overnight stay in Srinagar.

Day 2: Srinagar to Kargil via Sonmarg, Zoji La & Drass

- Wake up to a beautiful morning in Srinagar, enjoy a hearty breakfast, and get ready for your first long ride of the trip.
- Today is where the road trip energy truly kicks in as you ride through the famous meadows of Sonmarg, surrounded by dramatic landscapes and wide open skies.
- The excitement peaks when you cross Zoji La Pass, one of India's most thrilling high-altitude roads, known for its sharp turns, raw terrain, and adrenaline-filled views.
- You will ride through Drass, the second coldest inhabited place on Earth, and experience the feeling of entering Ladakh's rugged world.
- A powerful stop at the Kargil War Memorial will remind you of the bravery of Indian soldiers and leave you with a deep sense of pride.
- By evening, you will arrive in Kargil, check in to your hotel, enjoy a warm dinner, and settle in for the night. This is also your first chance to witness clear Himalayan skies for stargazing.
- Overnight stay in Kargil.

Day 3: Kargil to Leh – A ride through Ladakh's iconic landmarks

- Wake up to crisp mountain air in Kargil and fuel up with breakfast because today's ride is packed with unforgettable stops.
- You will cross Namika La and Fotu La, two high mountain passes that bring you closer to the heart of Ladakh.
- The landscape changes drastically as you pass through Lamayuru, famous for its moon-like terrain and the ancient Lamayuru Monastery.
- You will stop at the stunning confluence of the Indus and Zaskar rivers at Sangam Point.
- As you continue, you will experience the famous Magnetic Hill and visit Gurudwara Pathar Sahib.
- By evening, you will arrive in Leh and check into your hotel.
- Since Leh is at high altitude, acclimatization is crucial, so the evening is relaxed and focused on resting and hydrating.
- Overnight stay in Leh.

Day 4: Leh to Nubra Valley via Khardung La

- After breakfast, gear up for one of the most iconic rides of the entire Ladakh circuit as you head towards Khardung La, one of the highest motorable passes in the world.
- From the pass, you descend into Nubra Valley, a stunning region between the Karakoram and Ladakh ranges.
- Visit Diskit Monastery and the famous 106-foot Maitreya Buddha statue.
- Later, ride along the Shyok River and reach the Hunder Sand Dunes.
- Optional ATV ride and Bactrian camel ride in the evening.
- Overnight stay in Nubra Valley.

Day 5: Nubra Valley to Pangong Tso

- Wake up to a beautiful Ladakhi morning in Nubra Valley and begin your journey to Pangong Tso.
- Ride through the remote villages of Agam and Shyok.
- Witness the surreal blue shades of Pangong Lake.
- Check in to your campsite near the lake and spend the evening by the shore.
- Dinner and stargazing under a sky full of stars.
- Overnight stay near Pangong Lake.

Day 6: Pangong to Hanle via Rezang La

- Begin your day with sunrise at Pangong Lake, a quiet and unforgettable moment where golden light reflects on the crystal-clear water.
- After breakfast, you will start your journey towards Hanle, one of Ladakh's most remote and untouched regions.
- You will ride through Chushul, a high-altitude town near the Indo-China border, known for its strategic importance and breathtaking landscapes.
- A powerful stop at Rezang La War Memorial will honour the brave Indian soldiers who sacrificed their lives during the 1962 Indo-China war, making this ride deeply meaningful.
- As you continue, you will cross the scenic Loma Bridge over the Indus River, surrounded by vast landscapes that feel untouched by time.
- By evening, you will arrive in Hanle, a quiet village famous for its world-renowned astronomical observatory.
- Check in to your cozy homestay and enjoy a warm home-cooked dinner.
- The real highlight begins after sunset, when Hanle's sky turns into a galaxy of stars, one of the clearest night skies in India.
- This is the kind of night where you genuinely will not feel like sleeping, because the sky is too beautiful to look away from.
- Overnight stay in Hanle.

Day 7: The Ultimate Ride to Umling La

- Today is the most thrilling and high-altitude day of your journey as you set out to conquer Umling La, the highest motorable road in the world.
- After an early start and breakfast, you will ride through Ladakh's most rugged and remote terrain, crossing Photi La along the way.
- As the road climbs higher, the air becomes thinner, the terrain becomes rougher, and the landscapes become even more dramatic.
- Every kilometre feels like an achievement as you push deeper into the extreme high-altitude world.
- Finally, you will reach Umling La, standing higher than Everest Base Camp, and experience an unbeatable sense of accomplishment.
- Take in panoramic views, capture epic summit photos, and live the moment, because this is not just a ride, it is a true expedition milestone.
- After soaking it all in, you will begin your descent, crossing Nurbu La on the way back.
- By evening, you return to Hanle, where you can relax, reflect on what you just achieved, and once again experience Ladakh's unreal night skies in the comfort of your homestay.
- Overnight stay in Hanle.

Day 8: Hanle to Tso Moriri

- After breakfast, you begin your journey towards Tso Moriri, one of Ladakh's most pristine and breathtaking high-altitude lakes.
- The route takes you across remote landscapes and rugged terrains, crossing the Loma Bridge again as you ride towards Mahe.
- You will stop at Kyagar Tso, a small but stunning lake that reflects the clear blue sky, making it a perfect hidden gem for photos and quiet moments.
- As you continue, you will reach Tso Moriri, India's highest and largest saltwater lake, stretching across miles of untouched wilderness.
- The area feels peaceful, vast, and surreal, with the lake shimmering against the backdrop of mountains.
- You will check in to your guesthouse or campsite, enjoy dinner, and spend the night surrounded by pure silence and nature.
- Overnight stay in Tso Moriri.

Day 9: Tso Moriri to Sarchu

- Today is a true biker's dream day as you transition from Ladakh's lakes into the iconic Leh-Manali Highway.
- You will ride towards Puga Valley, famous for its steaming hot springs and bubbling mud pools, adding a fun and unique stop to your journey.
- Next, you will visit Tso Kar, a surreal saltwater lake with white salt deposits that contrast beautifully against deep blue water, making it one of the best photo spots of the trip.
- From here, you officially join the legendary Leh-Manali Highway, a route every rider dreams of conquering.
- You will cross Lachung La and Nakee La, two high mountain passes that push the adventure higher and higher, followed by the iconic Moore Plains, a long stretch of straight open road at high altitude that feels like pure biking freedom.
- Later, you will tackle the famous Gata Loops, a series of 21 hairpin bends that make this ride a thrilling challenge.
- By sunset, you will arrive in Sarchu, check in to your campsite, enjoy a hot meal, and unwind under a sky full of stars surrounded by rugged mountains.
- Overnight stay in Sarchu.

Day 10: Sarchu to Manali

- Today marks the final leg of your epic Ladakh bike journey and it ends with some of the most beautiful landscapes of the Himalayas.
- After breakfast, you will ride towards Baralacha La, a stunning mountain pass known for its dramatic views and unpredictable weather.
- En route, you will stop at Suraj Tal and Deepak Tal, two breathtaking alpine lakes where crystal-clear water mirrors the surrounding peaks.
- As you continue, you will pass through beautiful Himalayan villages like Darcha, Jispa, Keylong, and Sissu, each offering scenic views and a glimpse into mountain life.
- The excitement rises again as you ride through the Atal Tunnel, one of the world's longest highway tunnels at this altitude, offering a surreal transition from rugged mountains to greener valleys.
- Once you exit into Solang Valley, you will feel the landscape change instantly.
- By evening, you will arrive in Manali, check in to your hotel, and finally unwind after the long ride.
- Later, you can explore Mall Road, shop for souvenirs, and enjoy a cozy café meal in the hills.
- Overnight stay in Manali.

Day 11: Exploring Manali & bidding farewell

- Wake up to a relaxed morning in Manali and enjoy breakfast at your own pace, because today is for slowing down and soaking in the last moments of the mountains.
- You can spend the day exploring places like Hidimba Devi Temple, a beautiful ancient shrine surrounded by tall deodar trees, and visit Vashisht Temple and its hot springs, where the warm water helps you unwind after days on the road.
- Later, wander through Old Manali, known for its laid-back cafés, quirky streets, and river views, or stroll through Mall Road for final souvenir shopping and local treats.
- Enjoy one last meal in the mountains, and as the sun sets behind the hills, it is time to bid farewell to the Himalayas.
- Board your overnight bus to Delhi with a heart full of memories, a camera roll full of stories, and the bittersweet feeling that the trip ended way too soon.
- Overnight journey to Delhi.

Day 12: Back to Delhi

- After a long yet unforgettable journey, you'll arrive in Delhi by morning, marking the end of this incredible Ladakh adventure.
- Though the journey ends, Ladakh's beauty and adventure stay with you forever.

INCLUSIONS WITH ROADS YOU TRAVEL

- Transfers & Transport: Volvo transfer from Manali to Delhi (not included for self-bike option), Bike rental for 8 days (Day 2 to Day 9) for biking option, Fuel for bikes from Srinagar to Sarchu, Entire travel from Srinagar to Manali by tempo traveler (for Tempo Traveler option).
- Accommodation (10 Nights Stay): 1 night in a hotel at Srinagar, 1 night in a hotel at Kargil, 1 night in a hotel at Leh, 1 night in camps at Nubra Valley, 1 night in cottages at Pangong Tso, 3 nights in Homestay at Hanle & Karzok, 1 night in camps at Sarchu, 1 night in a hotel at Manali on triple sharing basis
- Meals (Total: 18 Meals) Day 2 - Day 9: Breakfast & Dinner
- Riding Gears & Support: Helmet (Standard Size: 58-60 cm), Riding Gloves (only for riders), Riding Jackets & Knee Pads (recommended to carry your own helmet for comfort), Team Captain throughout the trip, Mechanical Backup & Daily Bike Check-up, Spare wheels for punctures to avoid waiting time, Insurance
- Permits & Additional Services: All Inner Line Permits for the trip, Medical Kit & 24x7 Oxygen Cylinder in the car for emergencies, Driver Night Charges, Toll Tax, Parking Charges, etc.
